

HURON COUNTY ICE ARENA

ICE SKATING RULES

NOTICE: Skating is done at your own risk. Huron County and its employees are not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property.

1. Scribes, sticks, pucks, cones, and other skating implements are **NOT** allowed on public ice.
2. The first 1½ hours of a two-hour session will see skaters going counterclockwise while skaters will go clockwise for the final ½ hour. Skaters will skate counterclockwise on all sessions shorter than two hours.
3. Skaters must leave the ice when so instructed by the monitor and all skaters must be off the ice before the Zamboni enters the rink.
4. Games of a dangerous nature, such as “Crack the Whip” and “Tag”, are **NOT** permitted.
5. Pushing, tripping, or throwing of objects is **NOT** allowed.
6. All skating must be at a moderate speed.
7. During skating sessions no one is allowed on the ice without skates.
8. Food and beverages are **NOT** allowed on the ice.
9. Smoking is **NOT** permitted in the building.
10. Individuals not abiding by the rules **WILL BE** subject to be disciplined by the Arena staff, up to and including the temporary and/or permanent removal (banning) from the facility and property.
11. Individuals seen shooting pucks, balls, etc. against the Arena walls **WILL BE** asked to leave the Arena immediately.
12. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited.
13. Bullying is **NOT** allowed.
14. Skaters must obey the on-ice monitor.
15. Refunds will **NOT** be given to those individuals required to leave the ice.
16. Parents/Guardians are responsible for the actions of their children.
