

Bad Axe, Michigan

The regular meeting of the Huron County Board of Commissioners was held on Tuesday, August 31, 2010, commencing at 11:00 a.m. in the Board of Commissioners office, Third Floor, Huron County Building, Bad Axe, Michigan.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Peruski with The Lord's Prayer and Pledge to the Flag.

Commissioners present: Chairman Dave Peruski, Steve Vaughan, Kurt Damrow, Clark Elftman, John Horny, Jim Leonard and Ron Wruble.

The agenda was reviewed. The agenda will be corrected to add the Open Meetings Act between the discussion of the Social Security Act and the discussion concerning the VA Clinic.

Motion by Leonard, seconded by Vaughan to approve the agenda as corrected. Motion carried.

Jan Sternberg and Jeff Longbrake from Huron Medical Center appeared to discuss with the Board Title XVIII of the Social Security Act and the State Plan for Title XIX of the Social Security Act and to ask the Board to sign a contract with Huron Medical Center. They reported there is no cost to the County, there would be no impact to the Health Department, and it has potential to be beneficial to Huron Medical Center. It also would not make it necessary for the County to use Huron Medical Center only for health services. Discussion followed.

RESOLUTION by Safety Committee: #10-170 (Authorize the Chairman to sign a contract with Huron Medical Center that will allow for treatment of low income individuals who have been presented to the Huron County Jail and are in need of emergency health care.) **Motion** by Wruble, seconded by Elftman to dispense with the reading of the resolution. Motion by Horny, seconded by Elftman for approval of the resolution. Motion carried. Resolution adopted.

Steve Vaughan presents the Board with an update to the renovations at the VA Clinic. After reviewing a list of corrections to be done after a VA inspection, Vaughan reports the building should be finished by the end of this week with the exception of the VA logo which will be embedded in the floor at the entranceway. Bob Sobczak from Sobczak Construction was also present to report on the progress.

The dedication of the Veteran's Memorial is scheduled for September 11, 2010 and Vaughan is planning on an event at the VA Clinic as well.

Peruski reported that he had met with the architect pertaining to the new Health Department addition.
